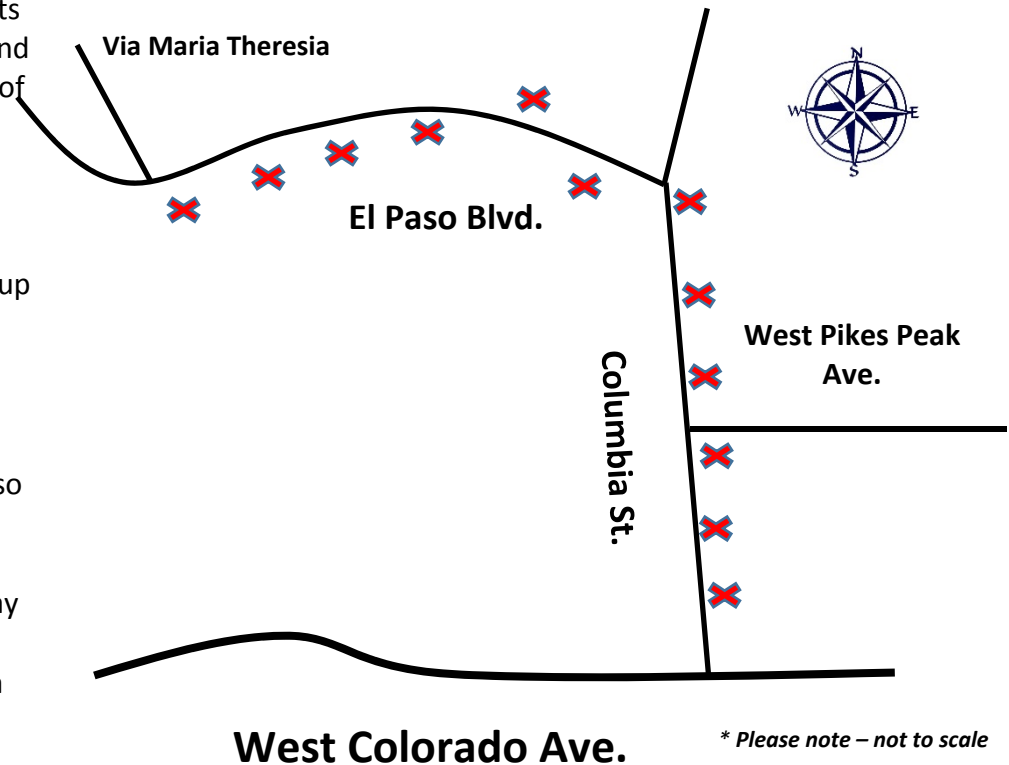


# Electric Overhead Construction

As part of Phase Two construction for the Westside Ave. Action Plan, Colorado Springs Utilities will be adding and upgrading infrastructure to its overhead electric lines. Beginning near the intersection of Columbia St. and W. Colorado Ave., crews will reframe electric poles and increase the size of overhead wire. The work will continue north to the intersection of El Paso Blvd., and then head west, terminating at a point near the intersection of El Paso Blvd. and Via Maria Theresa.

## What You Can Expect:

- Work will commence on Monday, May 7, and is expected to take up to a week to complete.
- Work hours are generally 7:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.
- Traffic will be coordinated with the Westside Ave. Action Plan project team.
- There will be alternate lane closures along Columbia St. and El Paso Blvd.
- Alternate access points during the construction will be:
  - Beckers Lane on the west; 36<sup>th</sup> St. on the east; and Highway 24.
- The project team requests that residents not park along Columbia St. or El Paso Blvd. during construction.
