

Traffic Advisory – Week of November 18

November 18 - 24: Crews will only be working a half day on Wednesday, November 21, and in observance of the Thanksgiving Holiday, no construction work will be done Thursday through Saturday, November 22 – 24.

New Impacts

There are no new closures for this week.

Continuing Impacts

Monday and Tuesday, construction work will have the following traffic impacts on Manitou / W. Colorado Avenue:

Colorado Avenue:

Traffic will be on the NORTH side of W. Colorado Avenue from Ridge Road to the bridge over Fountain Creek. One lane alternating traffic will be controlled by flaggers across the bridge (as required) during active construction work. During non-working hours, one lane in each direction will be open.

Traffic will be on the SOUTH side of Colorado Avenue from just east of Ridge Road to 32nd Street for utility work. One lane alternating traffic will be controlled by flaggers (as required) during active construction work. During non-working hours, one lane in each direction will be open. Access to roads and local business will be maintained on the north and south sides of Colorado Avenue.

Working hours are 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. unless otherwise specified (weather dependent).

Pikes Peak Avenue:

Crews will be working on Pikes Peak Avenue at the Ridge Road intersection from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. Pikes Peak Avenue will remain closed 24-hours-day at the intersection during this work.

Ridge Road Closure:

Ridge Road is permanently closed between W. Pikes Peak Avenue and W. Colorado Avenue.

Midland Trail Closure:

The Midland Trail is closed through Spring 2019 from Beckers Lane to Columbia Road for construction.
